

## General Information for Golf Course Monitors:

- o We are allowed on the golf course with the permission/agreement of the Golf Course management
- o Our presence is secondary to the presence of golfers and groundskeepers on the course, so be patient
- o Establish a routine and/or /schedule with the staff for having a golf cart at your disposal
- o Learn where to leave golf cart after you finish at hole 18
- o Drive the golf cart carefully and safely, it is not your cart.

## o Specific Actions

o In order to avoid interference with golfers, set up your monitoring plan to begin at hole 1, then hole 2, to hole 18, so that you are always moving in the same direction as the golfers.

o If you are approaching a golfer about to line up a shot - whether on the tee, on the fairway, or on the green about to putt, maintain a reasonable distance - roughly 50 yards - behind the golfer, and make no noise or movement that might be distracting.

o Be aware that sometimes a golfer might motion you to proceed ahead of them - and when so requested, move ahead quickly.

o If conversation is initiated by a golfer or groundskeeper, feel free to engage them. Consider passing out SCBC cards if it will not slow play.
